**Re: PCC Draft Land Use Bylaw - Update**

*Our purpose as provided under the Peggy's Cove Commission Act is to preserve the unique scenic beauty, character and atmosphere of the Area for the enjoyment of both residents and visitors for property within the Peggy's Cove Preservation area. This is primarily achieved through administering the Land Use Bylaws for the preservation area.*

On behalf of the Peggy's Cove Commission (PCC), I would like to inform you that the PCC has submitted the draft Land Use By-law to the Honourable Minister Susan Corkum-Greek on November 1, 2023 for approval, as per Section 8 and 10 of the *Peggy's Cove Commission Act*.

The current Peggy's Cove Land Use By-law (1993 as amended in 2003) is still in effect. The draft Land Use By-law will become effective following approval by the Minister, and the revised Land Use By-law will be filed in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds.
